All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This helps you to think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between funeral directors (because prices can vary)

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral directors charges only)	Price
This is a funeral where family and friends have a funeral ceremony event or service for the deceased person held at the same time & place as they attend their burial or cremation <i>These charges may be itemized as follows:</i>	£3,660
Taking care of the all the necessary and legal administration	£1,350
Collecting & transporting the deceased person from the place of death (15 miles) into the funeral directors care	£300
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's premises and at other non-branch premises.	£750
Providing a suitable coffin - an ethical business, this will premium cardboard, wood effect	£460
Viewing of the deceased person for family & friends by appointment on client request	£250
Taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery of crematorium in a hearse or appropriate vehicle	£550
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	Price
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself	
Burial (funeral directors charges only) Burial fees apply	£1,500
Cremation - All inclusive of funeral directors charges & cremation fees in named crematoria including hand return of ashes	£1,650
FEES YOU MUST PAY	Price
Attended or Unattended burial, the burial fee ¹ In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	£1,936-£2,194

ADDITIONAL PRODUCTS & SERVICES	Price
The funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and service, to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile)	£1.50
Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (ie to their home or place of worship etc (price per transfer)	£350
Collection & delivery of ashes	£100
Embalming not offered unless medically needed or requested	
Collection of the person who has died	£300
Funeral Officiant (celebrant, minister)	£250-£550
Services outside of office hours	Prices on request
Additional bearers (per person)	£85
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.	

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.
